## HOW TO REGISTER

Early registration is encouraged. Classes with insufficient enrollment will be canceled one week before the class is scheduled to begin. Please complete the course application. Send forms along with full tuition payment. You may also download a registration form online at [www.csmsg.org](http://www.csmsg.org). Upon receipt of your application and full tuition payment, we will send you an e-mail or letter confirming your registration. Checks returned for insufficient funds result in a fee. **Registrations received by June 1 are eligible for a 10% tuition discount.**

## CLASS CANCELLATION CHECKING THE STATUS OF A CLASS

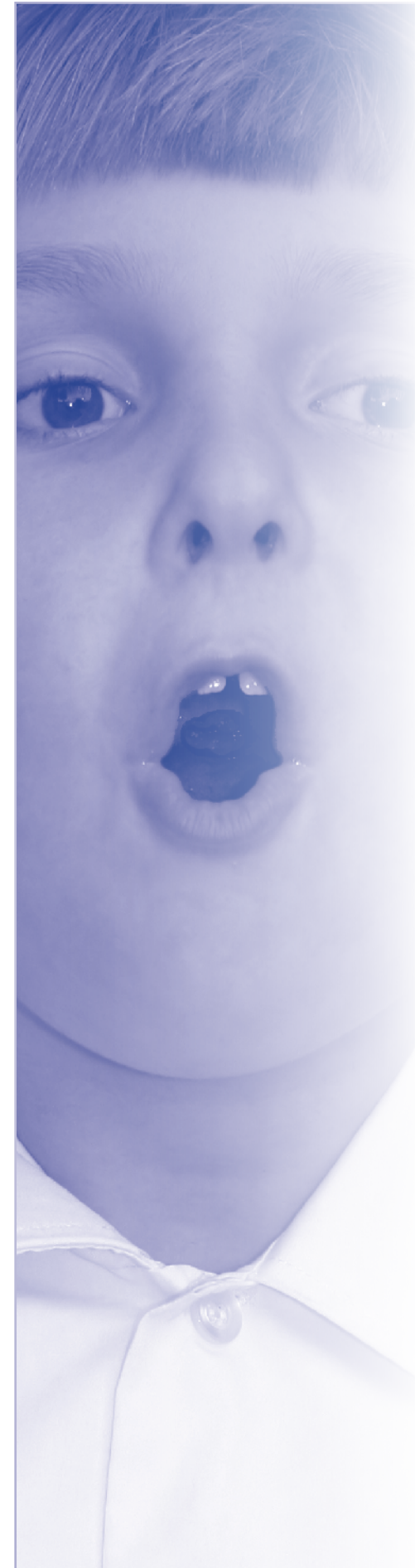
All classes are subject to cancellation due to insufficient enrollment. In case of cancellation, the office will attempt to contact all registered participants by phone or e-mail. Classes will be cancelled approximately one week before the class is scheduled to begin. Participants are encouraged to register early in order to facilitate appropriate planning. ## REFUND AND WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Participants enrolled in cancelled classes are entitled to a full refund of tuition. Participants who elect to withdraw from a class may not be entitled to a full refund/credit. Participants who wish to withdraw should contact the office. A refund for medical reasons applies only to absences of one week or longer and will require a doctor's note. Refunds for classes with limited enrollments are offered only if the space can be filled before the workshop begins. Therefore, if you must cancel, please let us know immediately so that someone else may take your place. All participants are expected to attend all class sessions.
