New York Genealogical and Biographical Society, dated October 24, 1952, is enclosed for your information.

Our early records are not complete as to membership lists and Confirmation records but it is recorded that Maria B. Mount made her first Communion at St. Paul's Chapel on Easter Day 1841, and that Susan Mount made her first Communion at the same Chapel on Easter Day 1848. In both records it is noted that these persons transferred to Trinity Chapel at some future time.

Susan Mount was the donor of three stained glass windows in All Saints' Chapel in Trinity Church, in memory of the Rev. Dr. Morgan Dix.

The above information is all that we have found on the Mount family, and we hope it will be of interest and assistance.
