- 323 '25 pledges received to date versus 301 at the same time in '24. \$115,000 incremental increase in pledges.
- \$2 million committed to date for Organ Fund

- Fr. Tom gave Laurie Brown's report. The Parents' Speakers' Series has been well attended by young parents and grandparents alike. Next meeting on March 30th
- Steak & Stories hosted Bill McClellan in February. It was a sellout.

- Hunger Ministries has been active making casseroles and sandwiches

- Annual Tea Party is April 26. Theme is Antique Road Show.
- May 18 is Outreach Ministries Fundraisers supporting Hunger, Shelter, Educational Equity, Episcopal City Mission, Racial Reconciliation, and St Michael's Houses.
